In this regard, Agent Gauder was a key member of the global, multiagency enforcement team that investigated and prosecuted what the media and legal commentators have described as "Honeygate," the largest food fraud and customs fraud cases in American history.

Agent Gauder has been investigating commercial fraud-related allegations since 2003, both as a federal agent with ICE-HSI as well as an officer with ICE's sister agency, U.S. Customs and Border Protection. He has been awarded some of the ICE's and CBP's highest law enforcement awards for exemplary service..
