RE:	Security Checkpoints/Documenting Legal Status

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security routinely sets up ad hoc security checkpoints in the interior of the United States -- in some cases, at a significant distance from the land border or port of entry. In such situations you will be required to present evidence of your immigration status. For this reason, you must carry documentation with you at all times to confirm your legal status. This is true even when traveling domestically, within the United States.
